

## **Study Leave for Foundation Doctors**

This document should be read in conjunction with the <u>All Wales Study Leave Policy for Doctors and Dentists in Training.</u>

## **Entitlements – Time & Budget**

The time entitlement in Foundation is split between the F1 and F2 years of training.

Up to 2 days for ALS course completion <sup>1</sup>	3 days for F2 Study Days <sup>2</sup>
Up to 5 days for tasters <sup>3</sup>	5 days generic teaching <sup>2</sup>
Up to 2 days general study leave <sup>4</sup>	Up to 5 days for tasters <sup>3</sup>
	Up to 8 days for general study leave <sup>4</sup>
Total – Up to 9 days	Total – Up to 21 days
No Study Budget available	£480 study budget

Foundation Doctors undertaking a Specialised F1 Programme are also entitled to take up to 5 additional days and £250 of study leave budget to support the academic component of their post.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> The ALS course is arranged by local postgraduate centres, usually towards the start of the training year.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> F2 Study Days and generic teaching are timetabled by Health Boards and attendance is compulsory.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Careers/Leadership tasters should ideally be undertaken within the same Health Board, although they can be undertaken within Wales where there is a specific reason.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup> General study leave can be taken to attend/present at conferences and for sitting exams necessary for career advancement. *Time off to prepare for exams and "private study" is not permitted.*
