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Sharing Training Excellence in Medical Education (STEME) 2018: Future-Proofing Education and Training

The Wales Deanery, in conjunction with Cardiff University's School of Medicine and Swansea University Medical School, is holding the following events for secondary care medical trainers in Wales in 2018:

STEME Conference

Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th September 2018,
Cardiff City Stadium, Cardiff

The themes for each day are:

DAY ONE:

- ▶ **A Changing Landscape**

DAY TWO:

- ▶ **Technological Innovation in Healthcare Education**

Trainers can register for just one or both days

STEME+

Tuesday 27th November 2018,
Ramada Plaza, Wrexham

The theme for this one-day event is:

Environmental and Technological Innovation in Healthcare Education

(Combining the two themes from the Cardiff event)

Please note: the programme for STEME+ will be very similar to the STEME Conference so you should only attend one event

The events are open to the four categories of secondary care medical trainer requiring recognition by the GMC, i.e.:

- ▶ Postgraduate Educational Supervisors of Junior Doctors
- ▶ Postgraduate Named Clinical Supervisors of Junior Doctors
- ▶ Lead Co-ordinators of undergraduate training at Local Education Providers (LEP)
- ▶ Doctors responsible for overseeing undergraduate students' educational progress for medical schools

The events will provide delegates with the latest information and newest developments in medical education and training as well as practical ideas to improve their educational practice. The programme will consist of stimulating keynote and plenary sessions, as well as a diverse range of practical professional development workshops covering key issues in medical education and training.

FREE ONLINE CPD

For those unable to attend in person, the plenary sessions for each day of the STEME Conference in Cardiff will be live-streamed via the Wales Deanery's YouTube channel, and the recordings will be made available online after the event.

Trainers will be able to claim 3 hours of CPD per day towards the requirements for the formal recognition of trainers in Wales for viewing and reflecting on the live-streamed/recorded sessions.

Important Note: If you would like to attend any of the days, you must register via the online registration process. **Registration will open on Monday 4th June 2018 and the link will be circulated via email on 1st June 2018.** Due to a very high demand for previous events, it is recommended that you book early to avoid disappointment. Places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. **We are unable to take bookings prior to registration opening.**
